

These are the chords most found in Ukulele Acc.

In order to avoid hard fingering, and to play all the popular songs written in flat keys, which are difficult for the Ukulele, the following will simplify playing:

Tune the Ukulele with the Piano as follows:

4th string	3rd string	2nd string	1st string
F	Bb	D	G

The key of Eb play as chords in key of G.

The key of Bb play as chords in key of D.

The key of Ab play as chords in key of C.

The key of Db play as chords in key of F.

The key of F play as chords in key of A.

This applies only when playing with the Piano.

This is only for accompaniments of songs. If solo work is desired, read solo part a third higher.

V = Up stroke, 1st finger, Right Hand.

□= Down stroke, Thumb, Right Hand.







