Basic Extra Spice - Switch to G chord on 2<sup>nd</sup> upstrum  $\downarrow \uparrow$ J↑  $\uparrow \downarrow \uparrow$ 2+ 3 4+ 1+ 2+ 3 + 4+ Starting vocal pitch – open E string Each chord gets either half of a basic strum, or half of an extra spice strum.
