Any kind of love without passion. that ain't no kind of lovin' at all, well

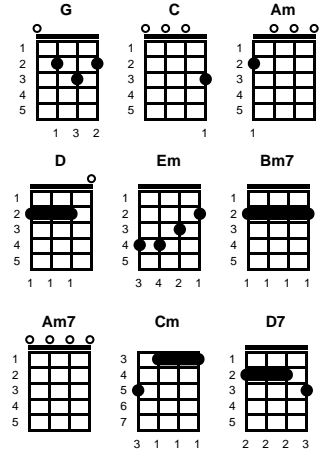
**v4:**
