v4:

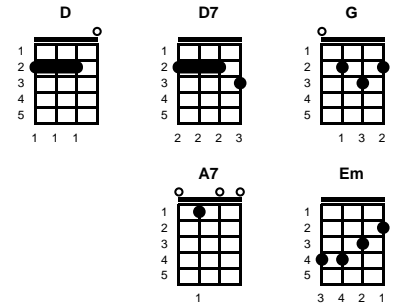
It's the sweetest thing I know of, just spending time with friends
