 -- **CHORUS**

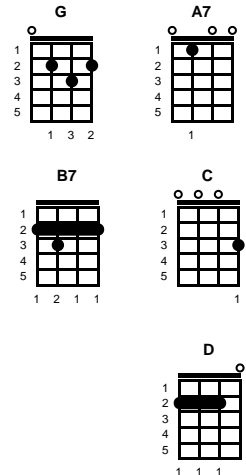
v4:
