 Glory, glory hallelu - jah! His truth is marching on

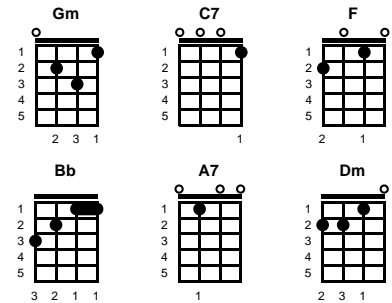
v2:
