To the sea, yes and how many years can some people exist
C **Dm** **G7** **C** **F**
Be - fore they're allowed to be free, yes and how many times
C **Am** **C** **F** **G7**
Can a man turn his head and pretend that he just doesn't see -- **CHORUS**

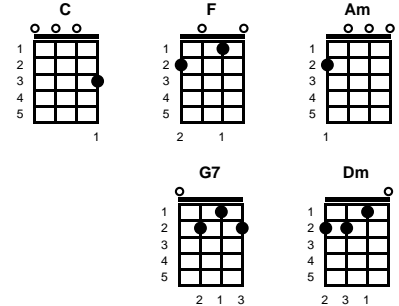
v3:

How many times must a man look up be - fore he can see the sky
C **F** **C** **Am** **C** **Dm**
Yes and how many ears must one man have be - fore he can hear
G7 **C** **F** **C** **Am**
People cry, yes and how many deaths will it take til he knows
C **F** **G7**
That too many people have died -- **CHORUS**
