v3:

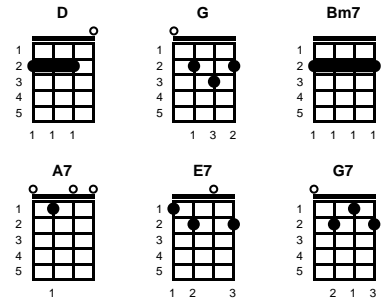
