D All the papers had to say was that Marilyn was found in the nude

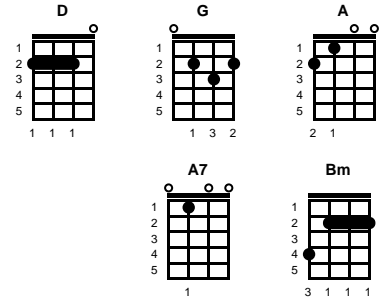
v3:
