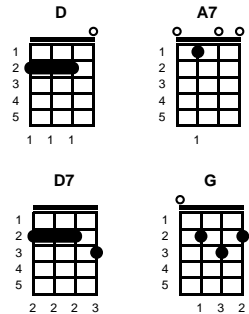
Another love before my time made your heart sad and blue **A7**
