Fixing around to have a dance, a - huh, a - huh, a - huh

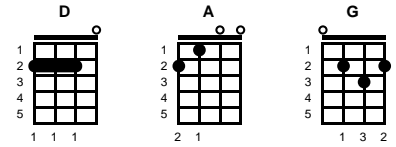
Next to come was the bumble bee, a - huh
