And I'm goin' back to New Orleans, to wear that ball and chain

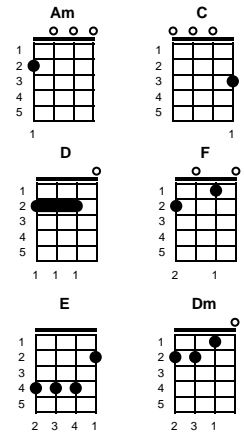
