G **D**
That means he's lost the will to live
I'm so lonesome I could die **A7 D Dsus4 D**

v4:

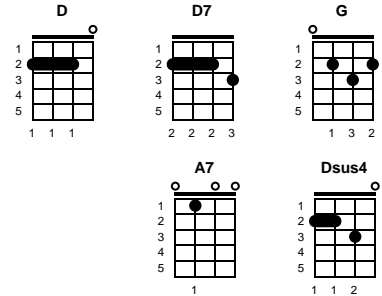
