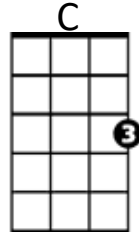


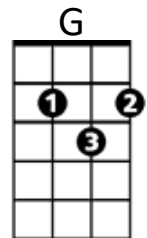
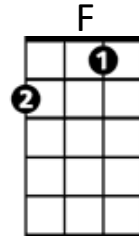
Jamaica Farewell
