 Though I've been from Maine to Mexico -- **CHORUS**

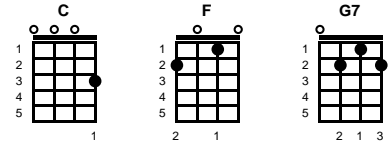
