No matter it never will be light

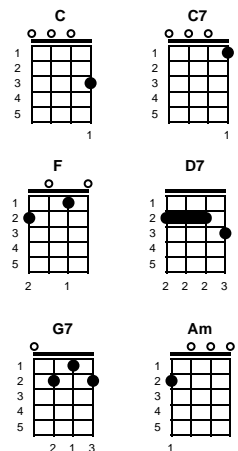
A few more days till we totter on the road
