Her Little heart was beating faster, waiting for her Indian brave -- CHORUS

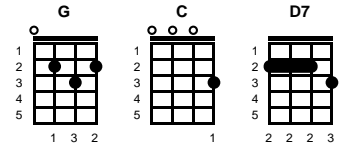
v3:
