She's a hard lovin' woman, got me feelin' mean

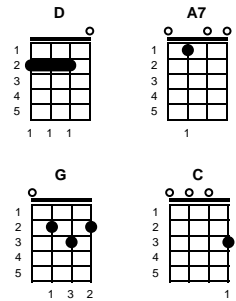
