Covered all over with sweet violets **C F C**

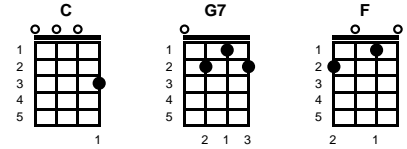
v2:
