 Where I'm gonna pine away, until my dying day

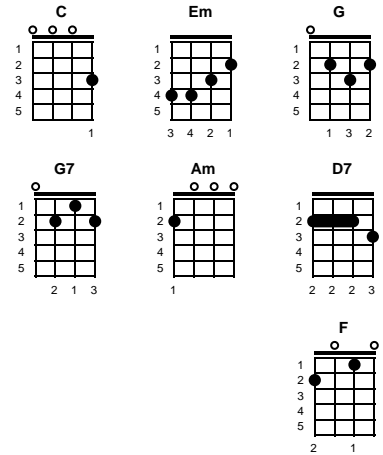
v3:
