A But I ain't turning back to living that old life no more -- **CHORUS/INTERLUDE**

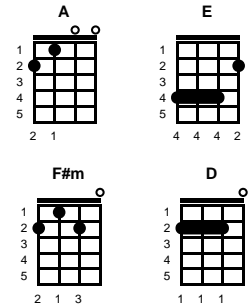
v3:
