D7 I can win your **G7** love for me

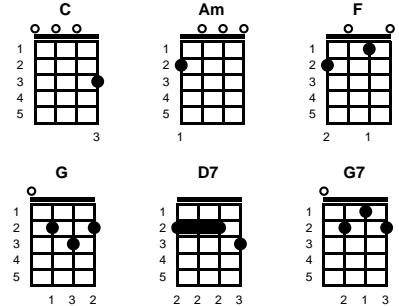
