The Beatles Songbook for April, 1964

In the first two weeks of April, 1964, the Beatles set two Billboard Hot 100 chart records.

On April 4, five songs by the Beatles occupied the top five spots on the Billboard Hot 100, the first time this has ever happened. The top five songs were:

- 1. Can't Buy Me Love (their 3rd #1 hit, April 4 May 2)
- 2. Twist And Shout
- 3. She Loves You (their 2nd #1 hit, March 21 & March 28)
- 4. I Want To Hold Your Hand (their 1st #1 hit, Feb. 1 March 14)
- 5. Please, Please Me

This record would hold for 57 years until Sept. 18, 2021, when Canadian rapper Drake captured the top five spots on the Hot 100. Other Beatles songs on the Top 100 that week were:

31. I Saw Her Standing There

65. You Can't Do That

41. From Me To You

68. Roll Over Beethoven

46. Do You Want To Know A Secret

79. Thank You Girl

58. All My Loving

Their one week total: 12 songs on the Hot 100 in one week; eight of these songs appeared on their February 1964 playlist. The week before, March 28, 1964, the group had 10 songs on the Hot 100. In subsequent weeks, the group would continue their remarkable run of popular music on Billboard's Hot 100.

On the April 11 the Beatles set another Hot 100 chart record. It was the first time that any performer or group had 14 songs on the Hot 100 at the same time. This record would hold for 51 years until it was broken by Drake on March 7, 2015. Twelve of the songs were the same as the April 4th chart but two songs were new:
