


All were performing as solo artists in the Toronto area before coming together in 2006 to perform at a Christmas concert at Toronto's Gladstone Hotel. Since then, they have toured in Australia, the UK, Europe, and the US, including the Kennedy Center. They have recorded two EPs and seven albums.

All three play acoustic guitar and both Caroline and Kerri play the banjo. In addition, Kerri and Sue play the ukulele and Caroline plays the baritone ukulele.
