21	Christmas in Dixie (C) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> As suggested on Sunday, I’ve transposed from C to the following keys: A, D, F, G. The favored key in the songbook was C. I closely listened to the MP3 and we’re missing two words in the first verse; they’ve been added (in red). The “Repeat From Chorus” was an error. At the end of the second verse, Alabama just sings the Chorus and the Outro (plus an instrumental tag). I purchased sheet music for this song, added time signature and corrected the tempo. A second version was created based on the sheet music. Aside from a couple of chord placement issues, the only other changes were Am → Am7 and Dm → Dm7. I think it sounds better. I also added the “Jingle Bells” tag but that’s just a personal thing; I’m not suggesting that we do it (or at least that everyone does it). 	22

I had put the Dean Martin version on the song sheet because of his phrasing. 	24
