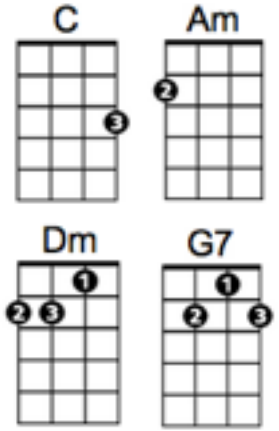

CHORUS x2: (try to sing the underlined on the downbeat)
