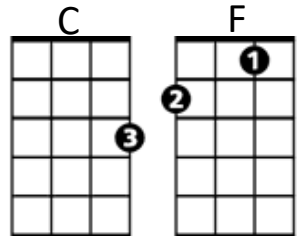


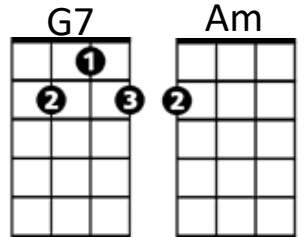
# Frosty the Snowman (S. Nelson & J. Rollins)



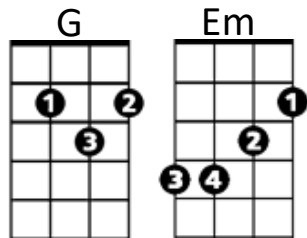
**C** Frosty the Snow Man was a jolly happy soul
