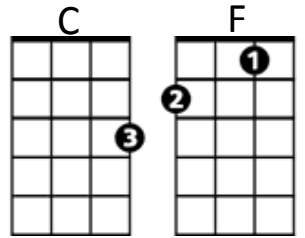


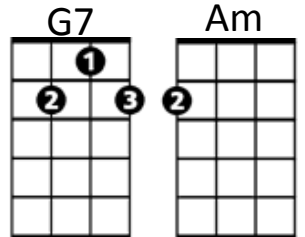
Frosty the Snowman (S. Nelson & J. Rollins)



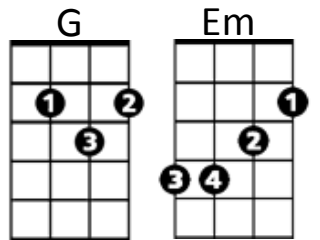
C Frosty the Snow Man was a jolly happy soul
