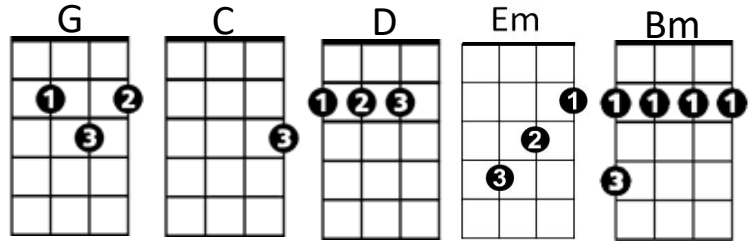


Grandma Got Run Over by a Reindeer (Elmo & Patsy)
