

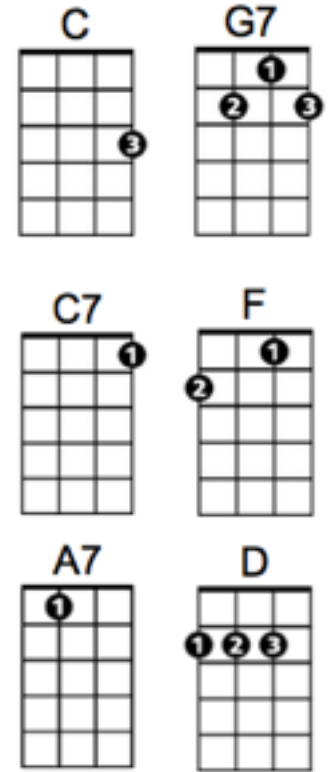

VERSE:
