

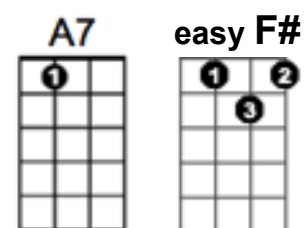
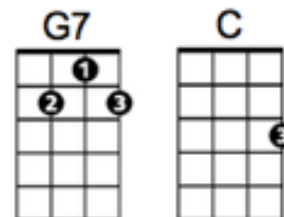
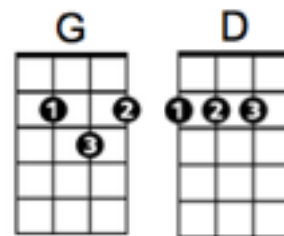
RUDOLPH THE RED NOSED REINDEER by Johnny Marks

1 bluesy (syncopated) island strum (D du udu) per chord

play one strum for / and two strums for //



*practice singing the underlined syllables on the downbeat to build your singing-while-playing skills

INTRO: G

VERSE:

G G G D
Rudolph the red-nosed reindeer had a very shiny nose
 D D D G
And if you ever saw it you would even say it glows
 G G G D
All of the other reindeer used to laugh and call him names
 D D D [G// - G7//]
They never let poor Rudolph join in any reindeer games

BRIDGE:

C G D G
Then one foggy Christmas Eve, Santa came to say
 D D A7 D
 "Rudolph, with your nose so bright, won't you guide my sleigh tonight?"

LAST VERSE:

G G G D
Then how the reindeer loved him as they shouted out with glee
 D D D G
 "Rudolph, the red-nosed reindeer, you'll go down in histo-ry!"

ENDING:

D D G G/ F#/ G/
You'll go down in his-to-ry
