I sincerely want to say -

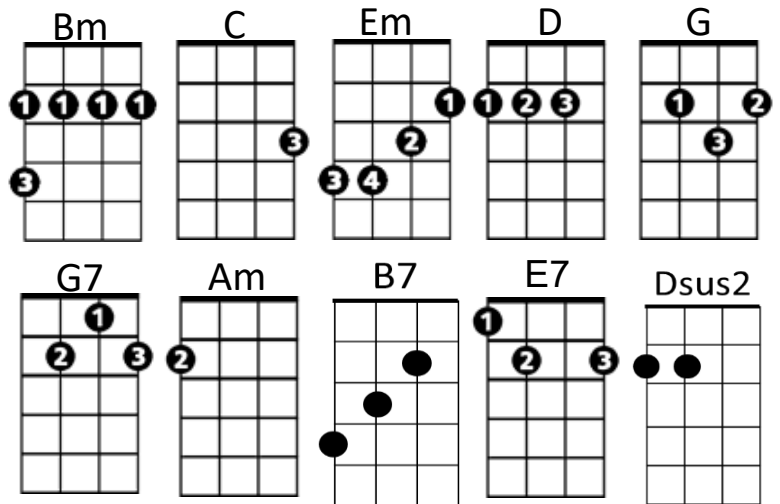
