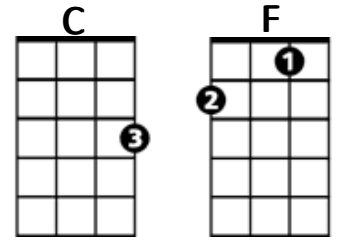


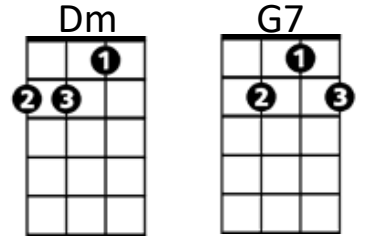
Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer (Johnny Marks)

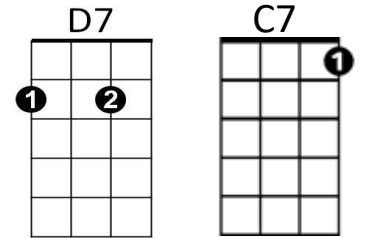
F **G** **F** **C**

 And if you ever saw it, you would even say it glows.

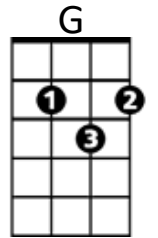


C **G7**
