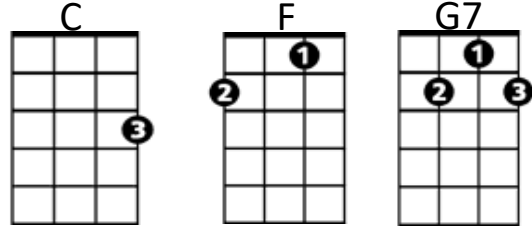
and Grace will lead me home.
