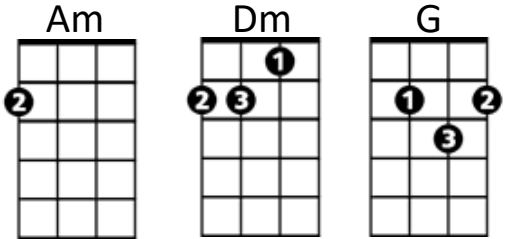
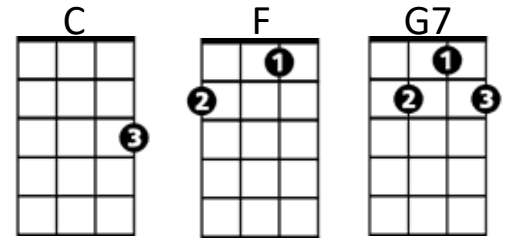

The F chord has the 1st string at fret 1, 2nd string at fret 2, 3rd string at fret 3, and 4th string at fret 3. The G7 chord has the 1st string at fret 1, 2nd string open, 3rd string at fret 2, and 4th string at fret 1. The Am chord has the 1st string at fret 1, 2nd string at fret 2, 3rd string at fret 2, and 4th string at fret 3. The Dm chord has the 1st string at fret 2, 2nd string at fret 3, 3rd string at fret 3, and 4th string at fret 3. The G chord has the 1st string open, 2nd string at fret 2, 3rd string at fret 3, and 4th string at fret 3.
