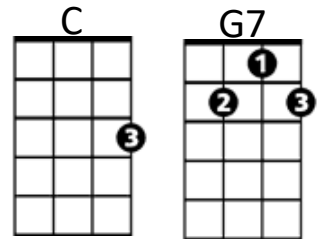


# Raindrops Keep Falling On My Head (Bacharach / Hal David)

Intro: C G F G

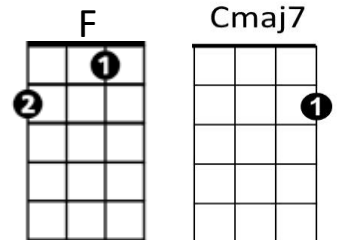
C Cmaj7

Nothing seems to fit - those raindrops are falling on my head

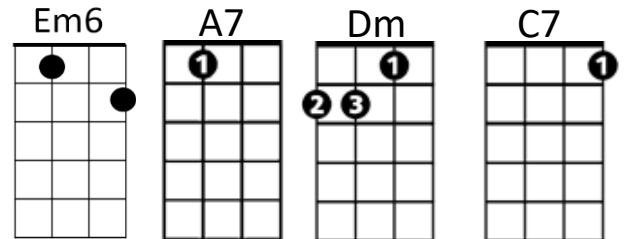
G7 C Cmaj7

They keep falling -

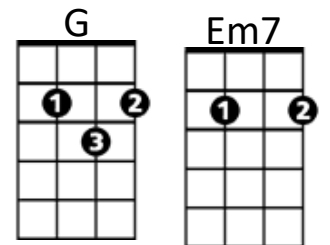


## Reprise:
