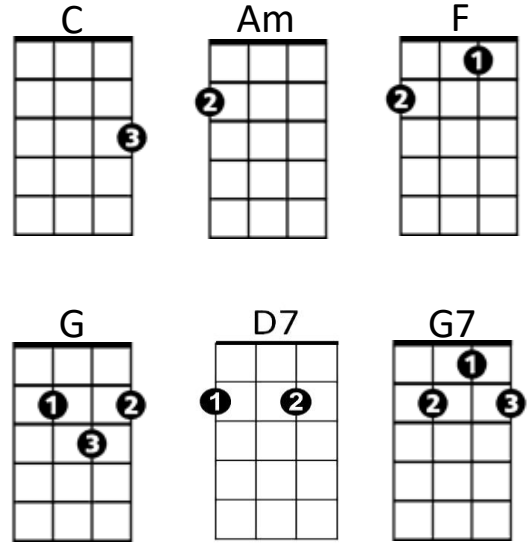


What a Wonderful World (Sam Cooke, Herb Alpert, Lou Adler)
