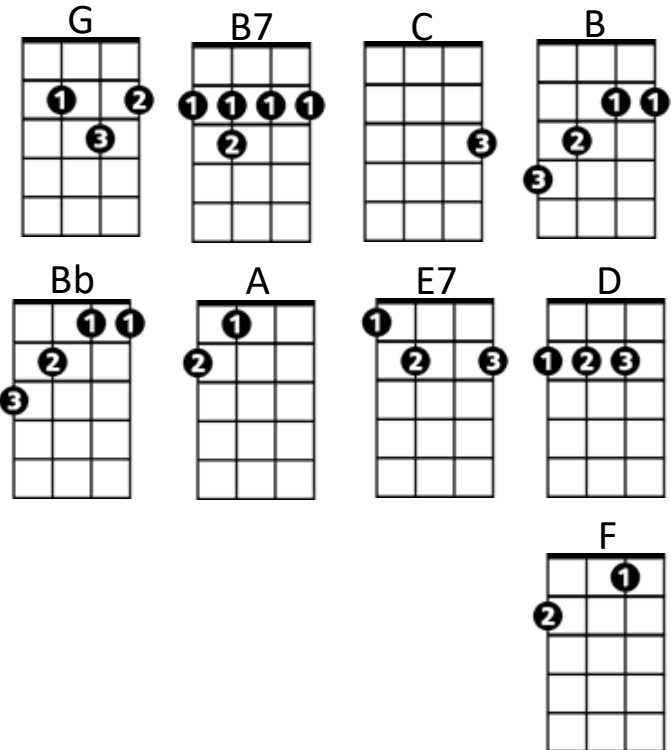

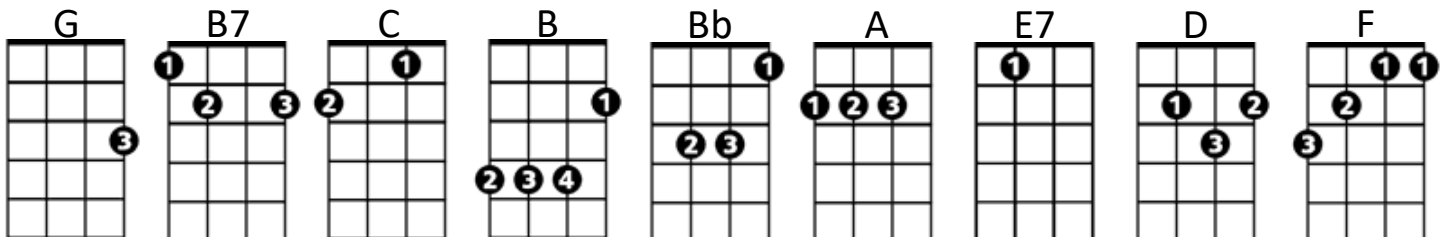

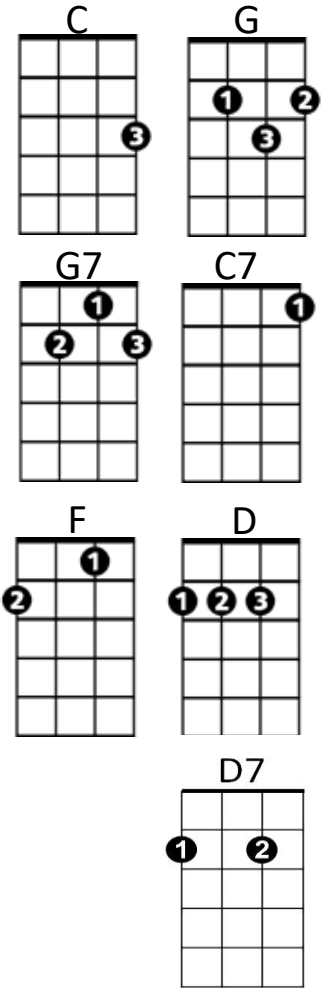

## Bridge:

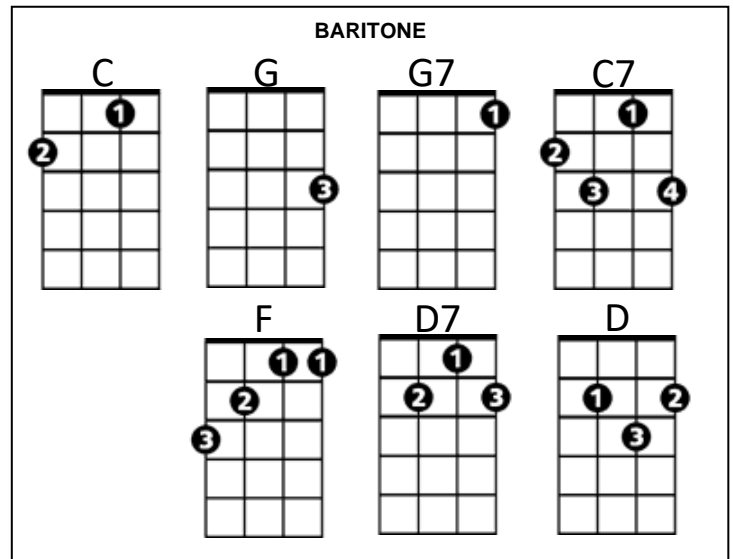
